

Meldanda is the name given to a property situated at the base of the Eastern Mount Lofty Ranges. The township of Cambrai is close by, and the River Marne when flowing courses its way through Meldanda.

The 100 acre property is overseen by the Cambrai Primary School Governing Council and currently being developed and maintained by Mid Murray Landcare SA, a not for profit community organisation.

Our collective ambition is to create a place of environmental learning where the preservation of native flora and fauna is actively encouraged.

Currently we can offer some facilities for hire and the use and enjoyment of various feature gardens and a selection of a few outdoor activities.

## **Details of our facilities**

Recreational Hut (aka the hub, approximately 20m x 6m), equipped with small kitchen, gas hot water, two gas ovens with gas cooktop, a selection of crockery and a large fridge with some freezer space.

The building has tables and chairs and can accommodate up to 30 people comfortably. A projector screen and white board are on hand with a limited 240 volt power source that provides lights and the ability to use electronic equipment e.g. projectors and laptops.

Outside we have a large gas plate BBQ, a fire pit with log seating and 2 outside tables and 3 toilets. Open ground provides an opportunity to pitch some tents in this small campground area, there is room for camper trailers or caravans in the large campround area.



## **Hireage Costs**

\$110 Inc GST to hire the recreation hall and includes access to the BBQ and shelter, toilets, camp fire and activities like; volley ball court, 9 basket Frisbee golf course, giant chess board, croquet set, binoculars, bird hyde and bird books, first aid kit, walking trails, Bush Stone-curlew shelter. Please note there is only hot water available in the kitchen.

Camp fees are \$5.50 Inc GST per night per adult and \$2.20 Inc GST per night per child. Individual campers or group bookings welcome. Please BYO firewood, fires only permitted in non fire ban season.

We ask all visitors to clean up after themselves, to be actively conserving the solar powered energy and tap water. We encourage visitors to leave minimal rubbish on site, and to comply with our recycling systems. We provide plates and cups to avoid unnecessary disposable items.

The township has an outdoor swimming pool, in summer months, a community library, general store, town hall, playground, and an agricultural museum which can be opened by arrangement. The nearby town of Sedan has a hotel, supermarket and petrol at the local post office. The Murray Plains Cycle Trek also passes through Cambrai. There is an astronomy paddock set aside for night time viewing of the stars, camping is permitted in this paddock and there is a portable toilet provided nearby.
